






# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Dominican Republic, the age 65+ population will increase 105% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 16%. For comparison, Dominican Republic's age 65-growth rate ranks #88 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #4 out of 17 in the Caribbean.






