



Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017




Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Cyprus ranks #54 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #2 out of 18 in Western Asia.

Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Cyprus, the age 65+ population will increase 77% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 12%. For comparison, Cyprus's age 65+ growth rate ranks #134 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #16 out of 18 in Western Asia.




Percent of Population Age 65+: 1970-2040

"Old Age" Dependency Ratio





Nhat is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

How does Cyprus compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Cyprus is 20.0. This means there are 20.0 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Cyprus ranks #55 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #3 out of 18 in Western Asia, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Cyprus was 35.9. The country ranks #60 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #2 out of 18 in Western Asia.

Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65




Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Cyprus is projected to average 80.8 from 2015-2020, ranking #35 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #2 out of 18 in Western Asia.

The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Cyprus was 8.4% in 2015, ranking #142 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
