


Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Côte d'Ivoire, the age 65+ population will increase 74% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 51%. For comparison, Côte d'Ivoire's age 65+ growth rate ranks #143 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #15 out of 16 in Western Africa.


