


Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Mozambique, the age 65+ population will increase 76% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by 59%. For comparison, Mozambique's age 65+ growth rate ranks #136 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #17 out of 20 in Eastern Africa.

"Old Age" Dependency Ratio





What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65-100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

How does Mozambique compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Mozambique is 8.3. This means there are 8.3 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Mozambique ranks #133 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #6 out of 20 in Eastern Africa, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



In 2015, the median age in Mozambique was 17.1. The country ranks #191 out of 201 nations and territories in the


