


# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Cambodia, the age 65+ population will increase 152% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 24%. For comparison, Cambodia's age 65+ growth rate ranks #24 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #3 out of 11 in South-Eastern Asia.



#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+
per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended
to measure burden on the working population to provide

#### How does Cambodia compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Cambodia is 7.6. This means there are 7.6 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Cambodia ranks #144 out o 201 nations and territories in the world, and #9 out of 1 in South-Eastern Asia, in terms of pressure on working



In 2015, the median age in Cambodia was 23.9. The country ranks #135 out of 201 nations and territories in the world and #9 out of 11 in South-Fastern Asia


