



#### Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017





## Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035


In Swaziland, the age 65+ population will increase 38% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 19%. For comparison, Swaziland's age 65+ growth rate ranks #178 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #4 out of 5 in Southern Africa.

#### "Old Age" Dependency Ratio





#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### How does Swaziland compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Swaziland is 7.5. This neans there are 7.5 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Swaziland ranks #147 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #3 out of 5 in Southern Africa, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Swaziland was 20.5. The country ranks #156 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 5 in Southern Africa.

#### Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65




Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Swaziland is projected to average 48.7 from 2015-2020, ranking #201 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 5 in Southern Africa.

### Labor Force Participation Rate, 2015



The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Swaziland was 8.8% in 2015, ranking #139 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
