Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017




Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Burkina Faso ranks #196 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #15 out of 16 in Western Africa.


Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Burkina Faso, the age 65+ population will increase 107% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 61%. For comparison, Burkina Faso's age 65+ growth rate ranks #84 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #6 out of 16 in Western Africa.

"Old Age" Dependency Ratio





What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

How does Burkina Faso compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Burkina Faso is 5.8. This means there are 5.8 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Burkina Faso ranks #191 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #15 out of 16 in Western Africa, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Burkina Faso was 17.0. The country ranks #192 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #13 out of 16 in Western Africa.


Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65



Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Burkina Faso is projected to average 59.8 from 2015-2020, ranking #184 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #11 out of 16 in Western Africa.

The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Burkina Faso was 48.7% in 2015, ranking #29 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
