



Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017






Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Sao Tome and Principe, the age 65+ population will increase 140% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 42%. For comparison, Sao Tome and Principe's age 65+ growth rate ranks #38 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #2 out of 9 in Middle Africa.




Percent of Population Age 65+: 1970-2040

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees. he old age dependency ratio in Sao Tome and Principe 57.1. This means there are 7.1 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Sao Tome and Principe ranks #157 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #6 out of 9 in Middle Africa, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Sao Tome and Principe was 18.5. The country ranks #179 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 9 in Middle Africa.


Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65



Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Sao Tome and Principe is projected to average 66.9 from 2015-2020, ranking #148 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 9 in Middle Africa.

The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Sao Tome and Principe was 19.9% in 2015, ranking #92 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
