




# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Estonia, the age 65+ population will increase 18% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will shrink 7%. For comparison, Estonia's age 65+ growth rate ranks #193 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #9 out of 11 in Northern Europe.



#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 654 per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### How does Estonia compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Estonia is 30.8. This means there are 30.8 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Estonia ranks #17 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #6 out of 11 in Northern Europe, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



In 2015, the median age in Estonia was 41.7. The country ranks #20 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 11 in Northern Europe.




