



### Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017




Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Kuwait ranks #199 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #16 out of 18 in Western Asia.

# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Kuwait, the age 65+ population will increase 378% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 28%. For comparison, Kuwait's age 65+ growth rate ranks #3 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #3 out of 18 in Western Asia.




### Percent of Population Age 65+: 1970-2040

#### "Old Age" Dependency Ratio





#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### How does Kuwait compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Kuwait is 2.8. This neans there are 2.8 people age 65+ per 100 people age 0-64. Based on this ratio, Kuwait ranks #199 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #16 out of 18 in Western Asia, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Kuwait was 31.0. The country ranks #80 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 18 in Western Asia.

#### Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65




Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Kuwait is projected to average 74.8 from 2015-2020, ranking #95 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #11 out of 18 in Western Asia.

### Labor Force Participation Rate, 2015



The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Kuwait was 11.7% in 2015, ranking #123 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
