

Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017





Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Luxembourg, the age 65+ population will increase 81% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 21%. For comparison, Luxembourg's age 65+ growth rate ranks #124 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 7 in Western Europe.




Percent of Population Age 65+: 1970-2040

"Old Age" Dependency Ratio





What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

low does Luxembourg compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Luxembourg is 22.0. This means there are 22.0 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Luxembourg ranks #48 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #7 out of 7 in Western Europe, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Luxembourg was 39.2. The country ranks #43 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #7 out of 7 in Western Europe.

Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65






Labor Force Participation Rate, 2015




