

#### Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017



Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Guyana ranks #118 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #12 out of 13 in South America.

# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Guyana, the age 65+ population will increase 142% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 7%. For comparison, Guyana's age 65+ growth rate ranks #33 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #2 out of 13 in South America.

The old age dependency ratio in Guyana is 9.3. This means there are 9.3 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Guyana ranks #114 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #12 out of 13 in South America, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Guyana was 24.7. The country ranks #128 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #11 out of 13 in South America.

#### Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65




Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Guyana is projected to average 66.8 from 2015-2020, ranking #149 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #13 out of 13 in South America.

### Labor Force Participation Rate, 2015



The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Guyana was 18.7% in 2015, ranking #96 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
