

Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017




Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Cabo Verde ranks #130 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 16 in Western Africa.

Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Cabo Verde, the age 65+ population will increase 125% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 21%. For comparison, Cabo Verde's age 65+ growth rate ranks #53 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 16 in Western Africa.




Percent of Population Age 65+: 1970-2040

"Old Age" Dependency Ratio





What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

How does Cabo Verde compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Cabo Verde is 8.3. This neans there are 8.3 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Cabo Verde ranks #133 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 16 in Western Africa, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Cabo Verde was 24.5. The country ranks #130 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 16 in Western Africa.

Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Cabo Verde is projected to average 74.2 from 2015-2020, ranking #102 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 16 in Western Africa.
