### Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017




Based on the percent of its population age 65+ in 2017, Montenegro ranks #46 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #10 out of 12 in Southern Europe.

# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Montenegro, the age 65+ population will increase 43% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will shrink 3%. For comparison, Montenegro's age 65+ growth rate ranks #174 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #6 out of 12 in Southern Europe.




### Percent of Population Age 65+: 1970-2040

#### "Old Age" Dependency Ratio





#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### How does Montenegro compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Montenegro is 22.4. This means there are 22.4 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Montenegro ranks #44 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #10 out of 12 in Southern Europe, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



Median Age: 1970-2040

In 2015, the median age in Montenegro was 37.6. The country ranks #52 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #10 out of 12 in Southern Europe.

#### Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65



Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in Montenegro is projected to average 76.6 from 2015-2020, ranking #68 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #10 out of 12 in Southern Europe.

The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in Montenegro was 3.1% in 2015, ranking #173 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
