




Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In El Salvador, the age 65+ population will increase 67% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 5%. For comparison, El Salvador's age 65+ growth rate ranks #149 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #8 out of 8 in Central America.





Total life expectancy at birth among all men and women born in El Salvador is projected to average 73.9 from 2015-2020, ranking #106 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 8 in Central America.

Labor Force Participation Rate, 2015



The combined labor force participation rate among men and women age 65+ in El Salvador was 32.0% in 2015, ranking #58 out of the 180 nations and territories for which this is measured.
