


Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Turkey, the age 65+ population will increase 113% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 12%. For comparison, Turkey's age 65+ growth rate ranks #77 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #12 out of 18 in Western Asia.






