



Percent of Population Age 65+, 2017






Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Saint Lucia, the age 65+ population will increase 106% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 10%. For comparison, Saint Lucia's age 65+ growth rate ranks #85 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #3 out of 17 in the Caribbean.

Life Expectancy (Age) At Age 65




