




# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Mauritania, the age 65+ population will increase 116% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 46%. For comparison, Mauritania's age 65+ growth rate ranks #72 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #4 out of 16 in Western Africa.


