In Albania, the age 65+ population will increase 75% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 0%. For comparison, Albania's age 65+ growth rate ranks #141 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 12 in Southern Europe.


