


# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Lithuania, the age 65+ population will increase 9% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will shrink 9%. For comparison, Lithuania's age 65+ growth rate ranks #198 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #10 out of 11 in Northern Europe.


